The Academy will not be bulk buying the course materials for CFR courses as you can now purchase them from PHECC via paypal. So I would advise that you allow plenty of time pre course to purchase and take delivery of the course materials.

Please remember that it is YOUR responsibility to get online and complete the update as soon as possible.

We will be running a CFR & EFR skills update on October 9th in Cork , however this date will only be available to instructors who have completed the online section first. PHECC will email me the list of instructors who have completed the update as once as they have completed it.

To all CFR Instructors,

Thank you for your patience while we finalised our new CFR training products. I would like to tell you how to access the **Online CFR Instructor update**. Completion of this update is essential before you can start delivery of the new **CFR Community Course**.

Please follow the steps below to access, register and complete the online CFR Instructor update. This course will be available free of charge until the end of November, after which a fee may be imposed. It is not essential to have the new CFR Instructor manual or DVD to complete this update.

1. PHECC's online academy can be accessed from our home page www.phecc.ie under *News and Events* or by using this link [Online Academy Login & Registration](#)
2. All CFR Instructors are first time users and will need to register (this includes any paramedics or APs who have previously registered for courses). The registration information you provide will automatically transfer onto the course completion certificate. You will need your CFR Instructor certificate number and expiry date at hand.
3. Following successful registration, you will receive a confirmation email usually within 24 hours and you can start the update.
4. As it may be your first time using this service, you are advised to first watch the short video available from the online academy home page. When you have done this, the course should be a more enjoyable experience.
5. If you continue to have any IT difficulties at this stage, you can contact support@dillonproductions.com
6. There is no exam on completion. Instead you are invited to review the new information (ILCOR guidelines and CPGs), familiarise yourself with the new training products and actively participate in this e-learning experience. The course should take no longer than 40 minutes; however, you can pause and exit, re-enter and repeat as often as needed.
7. On completion you can print off your certificate or choose to have it emailed to you.
